



Modified Visitor Guidelines

For your safety and for the safety of our colleagues, we are currently observing modified visitation guidelines based on a Moderate Spread risk of COVID-19.

Guidelines are subject to change based which risk level the county is in.

All visitors must meet the following criteria:

- 12 years of age or older
- Screen negative for illness at entry points
- Not have recent COVID infection or be suspected of having COVID-19
- Not have close contact with a person who has confirmed or suspected COVID-19 in the past 14 days

All visitors must follow the below guidelines:

- Check in at entry points and wear a visitor badge at all times
- Hand sanitize at entrance and sanitize or wash hands as needed throughout visit
- Wear a facility-provided mask through the entire visit

Hospital Patients/Inpatient Visitation Restrictions:

- Exceptions for visitation may be made by the care team for trauma or critically ill patients (note: visitors may be asked to leave and return, or limit one visitor at one time depending on care and safety needs).
- One spiritual support visit per day at request of patient/family
- Special Care Nursery & Peds will allow 2 banded visitors per patient
- LDRP/WI- 2 support visitors allowed, with 1 leaving 2 hours post-delivery (note: if COVID positive, patient may have one healthy visitor per day)
- No visitors for COVID+ or COVID R/O patients unless End of Life; Trauma or critically ill patients at discretion of care team
- Behavioral Health Unit patients may not have visitors unless the treatment plan specifies need
- One visitor per patient at a time in double occupancy rooms

Emergency Department:

- One visitor will be allowed per patient (2 for pediatric patient)
- Exceptions for visitation for trauma and critically ill patients may be made at the discretion of the care team

Outpatient Surgery:

- One visitor allowed to accompany patient before and after surgery
- Visitor can wait in designated waiting area, café or coffee shop during surgery

Outpatient Care Settings:

- One visitor allowed to accompany patient to medical appointment as needed and as space allows
- Children's Health Center/Pediatrics will permit up to two visitors (parents/guardians) per patient
- Visitor can wait in designated waiting area, café or coffee shop
