On May 26, 1998, the Governor signed the "Vulnerable Adults Bill," SB1050-432R, introduced in response to concerns regarding the risk of abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation of incapacitated and vulnerable adults. This legislation applies to hospital based skilled nursing facilities.

As part of their student clinicals, your son/daughter will be working in FMC's skilled nursing unit. In order to be part of this program, the student must be fingerprinted.

Specific information about how to have the fingerprints taken, how they are processed and associated costs is forthcoming. Since your student is not yet 18, we are asking that you give written permission to have their fingerprints processed. Failure to comply with this requirement will preclude your student from participating fully in the program.
