Course Description

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) is an educational program consisting of an online exam (completed before attending class), integrated skill stations, and simulations with debriefing that are designed for health care professionals involved in any aspect of neonatal resuscitation. This includes physicians, nurses, advanced practice nurses, nurse midwives, licensed midwives, respiratory care practitioners, and other healthcare professionals who provide direct care during resuscitation. Successful completion earns the participant an electronic NRP Provider ecard. Neonatal Resuscitation Program provider status should be renewed every 2 years.

Prerequisites

The NRP Course format now requires learners to study the material from the *Textbook of Neonatal Resuscitation*, 8th *Edition*. Upon registering for a class, you will be issued a User ID and Password in order to complete the course curriculum, online through American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

You MUST COMPLETE ALL

SECTIONS in order to attend the in-person portion of the course, which is the Instructor Led Event. After completion and passing the Instructor Led Event, you will be issued your NRP eCard.
